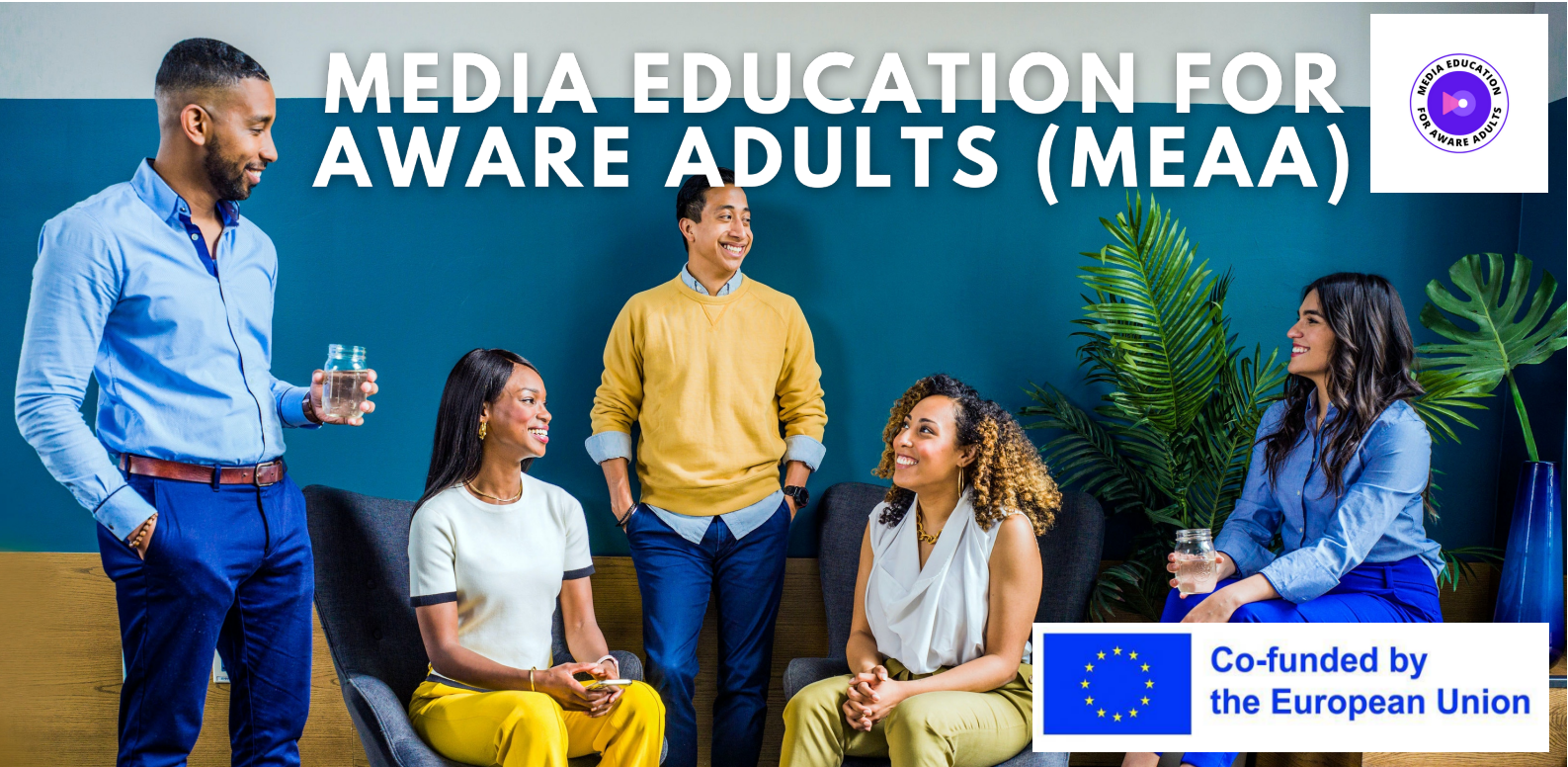


# MEDIA EDUCATION FOR AWARE ADULTS (MEAA)

## THE PROJECT:

MEAA is 24-month Erasmus+ Project that intends to improve the digital literacy of educators that lack the resources to help adults in the continuously evolving and expanding digital world and enable organisations who work with adults to expand their educational offerings and have new open source digital tools. Partners from six European countries will bring their expertise together and create Adult educators/trainers Digital Competences Framework, a Handbook - Media Education for Aware Adults, Online platform and training material on MEDIA EDUCATION and develop recommendations.

### Project Result 1:

Handbook - Media Education for Aware Adults (In progress)

#### Aim:

To be a valuable resource for adult educators working with adults from all over Europe. From a technical and pedagogical standpoint, the Handbook will provide basic knowledge and practical tools to be used.

### Project Result 2:

Adult educators/trainers Digital Competences Framework" (In progress)

#### Aim:

The Framework of Digital Competences will outline the essential skills that adult educators and trainers must possess in order to successfully incorporate media education and digital tools into their particular local contexts. It will also offer and validate an EU reference framework for creating and assessing digital competences.

### PROJECT RESULT 3:

"Online platform and training material on MEDIA EDUCATION"

#### Aim:

We will create a cutting-edge e-learning platform to help educators and trainers gain a solid understanding of digital media and digital literacy so they can impart that knowledge to others as part of their jobs. The resources included in the digital learning packages will range from interactive games, podcasts, e-learning films, interactive case studies, and infographic tools, among others. As expected, it will be a collection of digital learning materials built around the idea of micro-learning.



## PARTNERS' MEETING:
