About the project

The project Preventing Radicalization within European School Education (PRAISE) is an EU-funded collaborative project that aims to prevent radicalization in the school environment and create material that schools should be able to use to work actively against radicalization. The project includes three secondary schools (from Sweden, Ireland and Romania) and also nongovernmental organizations that work with social science issues (from Ireland, Cyprus, Italy and two from Greece). The project runs until September 30, 2025 and has a budget of €250,000. We will create digital as well as analog material, test this in school environments and disseminate the results at national conferences in all project countries.





Kick-off meeting in Borås

The Kick-off meeting in Borås was held on 14-15 November. All partners were represented and the initial strategies could be worked out. The focus was mainly on the desk and field research that will form the PRAISE Competences Pathway and thereafter inform the PRAISE Innovative Training Curricula & Material for School students and the E-learning platform and digital board game.
