About the project

The project Preventing Radicalization within European School Education (PRAISE) is an EU-funded collaborative project that aims to prevent radicalization in the school environment and create material that schools should be able to use to work actively against radicalization. The project includes three secondary schools (from Sweden, Ireland and Romania) and also nongovernmental organizations that work with social science issues (from Ireland, Cyprus, Italy and two from Greece). The project runs until September 30, 2025 and has a budget of €250,000. We will create digital as well as analog material, test this in school environments and disseminate the results at national conferences in all project countries.

Several online Meetings have taken place to allow the group develop educational material relating to various aspects of the project.

As a result of the Desk and Field Research findings each partner was responsible for developing educational resources in two key areas in the prevention of radicalisation.


The group are currently working on developing and piloting a digital resource, an educational game that focuses on the prevention of radicalisation.



Educational Material

The group has now created a number of resources designed to address the key areas identified during the field and desk research stage. The areas identified are:

- Critical Thinking
- Intercultural Dialogue
- Introduction to Socio-ecological Resilience
- Adaptability to changes
- Constructive dialogue
- Understanding socio-cognitive factors shaping human behavior
- Lifelong learning
- Democratic behaviour

As a result of the research, calloboration of educational material a Digital Game has been developed and is currently at the piloting stage.

It is hoped that this resource when completed will be a valuable and engaging tool allowing young people who interact with this platform to develop the necessary skills and strategies to navigate challenges they may encounter in the area of radicalisation.
