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DSD BEST PRACTICES COLLECTION

Learning from Successful European Examples

One of the first achievements of the project is the development of the **DSD Good Practices Collection**, bringing together inspiring examples of Education for Sustainable Development (ESD) and Technology-Enhanced Active Learning (TEAL) from all partner countries.

The collection highlights innovative and educational approaches, community initiatives, environmental projects and digital learning practices that support sustainability competences among adult learners.

Main achievements:

- ✓ Collection of good practices from five European countries
- ✓ Analysis of innovative sustainability education approaches
- ✓ Identification of transferable methods and tools
- ✓ Resource for educators and organisations across Europe

DSD TOOLKIT DEVELOPMENT

Practical Tools for Sustainable Learning
Building on the research phase, partners developed the DSD Toolkit, a practical educational resource designed for adult educators, trainers and organisations. The toolkit combines sustainability topics with active and participatory learning approaches based on TEAL methodology.

Toolkit includes:

- Interactive learning activities
- Facilitator guidelines
- Sustainability education modules
- Digital learning tools
- Collaborative and experiential learning methods

To ensure quality and relevance, all materials underwent an international peer-review process involving project partners and experts.



INTERNATIONAL TRAINING IN ZARAGOZA



Learning, Teaching and Training Activity (LTTA)

From 31 March to 2 April 2026, project partners and educators gathered in Zaragoza, Spain, for the Learning, Teaching and Training Activity (LTTA).

The training provided an opportunity to explore project results, exchange experiences and test newly developed educational resources in an international environment.

Participants worked collaboratively to evaluate materials and provide feedback that will support the finalisation of project outputs and improve their practical application in adult education settings.



DIGITAL TOOLS FOR SUSTAINABILITY



E-Learning Platform

During the LTTA, participants tested the newly developed DSD E-Learning Platform, which provides access to educational modules, learning resources and digital tools supporting sustainability education.

The platform is designed to offer flexible learning opportunities for educators and adult learners across Europe



Interactive Simulation Exercises

Participants also tested the Interactive Simulation Exercises developed within the project.

These simulations encourage active participation and experiential learning, helping users better understand sustainability challenges through practical scenarios, decision-making processes and collaborative problem-solving.

The feedback collected during the LTTA will help further improve both digital resources before wider implementation.
